
Creating a new Top Videos package


How to enter the Top Videos page

Choose **Packages** in the Top Videos tab

What is a Package?

A combination of 5 previews under the Top Videos component.


The package can be created and updated automatically (default) and can be created and edited manually.



Click on the packages tab to see all the live packages.

Clicking on the package line, a tab will be open on the right side of the screen where you can:

1. Export a div code for the Top Video
2. Delete the package
3. Edit the package title and content
4. Create a new package




How to Create a New Package

Choose **Editor** from the menu in the Top Videos tab

or

Click NEW in the packages page (see previous page)



Creating a New Package:

Choose the APVs you would like to include by dragging them to the middle column.

Choose the title and the Embed name

Click "Publish"

Copy the div of the new package and add it to the relevant page in your CMS.
